After arguing this case for some time, learned counsel for the appellant states that the appellant will be satisfied if time of three months is granted to her for handing over the vacant possession of the suit property to the decree holder.

Learned counsel for the caveator/respondent(s) has no serious objection to the aforesaid course.

In view of consensus reached between the parties, time upto 27.10.2017 is granted to the appellant to hand over the possession of the property to the decree holder without creating any hindrance whatsoever. This order is however subject to filing of an undertaking in the aforesaid context by the petitioner before the executing Court within a week. In case of any

violation of the undertaking by the appellant, the same shall be viewed with serious consequences. During the aforesaid period of three months, appellant shall not be dispossessed from the premises.
