ANITA CHAUDHRY, J.

This is an appeal by the driver and owner against the award dated 20.02.2016. The statutory amount of Rs.25,000/- has not been deposited. On the last date of hearing, learned counsel for the appellants has sought time to produce case law wherein exemption has been granted to deposit the statutory amount. Learned counsel has failed to do so. He has submitted that the appellants are not in a position to deposit the statutory amount and they may be exempted.

Though, notice has not been issued, Ms. Vandana Malhotra, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of Insurance Company and has opposed the prayer.

Since the statutory amount has not been deposited, the instant appeal is dismissed.
