On the previous date of hearing i.e. 27.09.2017, this Court had passed the following order:

“Last opportunity was granted to the learned counsel for the appellants to furnish the correct addresses of the respondents to ensure their service. Office report indicates that compliance is still awaited. Instead an adjournment slip has been moved. Though there is hardly any justification to defer the proceedings, but in the interest of justice, matter is adjourned to 11.10.2017.

Let the needful be done before the next date of hearing, failing which the appeal shall stand dismissed for non-prosecution without any further reference to the Bench.”

Office report dated 07.10.2017 indicates that notices could not be issued to the respondents as counsel for the appellants did not furnish their correct addresses.

Learned counsel for the appellants submits that despite repeated communications, the appellants have failed to respond or contact his office.

That being so, the Court is choice-less but to dismiss the appeal for non-prosecution.
