Heard the submissions made on either side.

Counsel for the respondent brings to the notice of this Court that the orders passed by us right from 13.10.2015 were not complied with. It is brought to our notice by the counsel for the respondent that the appellant is liable to pay a sum of ₹1,05,000/- towards arrears of maintenance.

We, in fact, dismissed the appeal for non-compliance of our directions to pay the arrears of maintenance on 10.01.2017. Thereafter in the interest of justice, the appeal was restored to its original number with a direction to pay the arrears of maintenance.

Counsel for the appellant, on instructions from the appellant, submits that the appellant is unable to pay the maintenance as ordered by us.

We have no other option except taking a decision to dismiss the appeal for non-payment of arrears.

Accordingly, the appeal is dismissed in default of payment of arrears as ordered by us.
