Learned counsel for the appellant has submitted that the parties have filed a petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act in the matrimonial Court at Kaithal pursuant to the settlement arrived at between them before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court on 30.03.2017.

It has also been informed that petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act, is now fixed for 20.10.2017 for final disposal after recording the second statement of the parties.

In view of the settlement arrived at between the parties before the Mediation and Conciliation Center of this Court and the subsequent events, this petition is disposed of as having rendered infructuous leaving the parties to obtain a decree of divorce under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act without prejudice to the right of the parties to seek revival of this petition in case the terms of settlement are not taken to logical end.
