1. The appellant-husband has challenged the judgment and decree dated 13.08.2015 passed by learned Additional District Judge, Tarn Taran whereby petition filed by the respondent-wife under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (for short, 'the Act') seeking dissolution of marriage by way of divorce on the ground of cruelty has been allowed.

2. During the pendency of the appeal, the matter was referred to the Mediation & Conciliation Centre of this Court to explore the possibility of settlement between the parties.

3. Learned counsel for the parties state that both the parties have settled their dispute by way of an amicable settlement/agreement on 27.02.2017 wherein it was agreed that the present appeal filed by the appellant before this Court be withdrawn. It was also agreed that the parties shall remain bound by the terms and conditions of the agreement/settlement.

4. Learned counsel for the appellant submits that in view of the agreement/settlement, referred to above, he may be permitted to withdraw the present appeal.
