Though the efforts taken by the Court to settle the matrimonial dispute that has arisen between the parties through Mediation & Conciliation Centre have failed.

Counsel appearing on either side submit that the matter was amicably settled out of Court. It is also submitted that the parties have already moved the trial Court with necessary joint petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act seeking divorce by mutual consent.

In view of the above development in this case, counsel for the appellant seeks permission to withdraw the appeal. The appeal stands dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to the parties to revive the appeal, if at all the prayer for divorce by mutual consent did not fructify.
