The husband is in appeal before this court challenging the judgment of the court below, whereby the petition for divorce filed by him was dismissed.

On 11.7.2016, this court passed the following order:

“We have gone through the entire evidence. We find that there is no merit in the appeal.

As the appeal has arisen out of the matrimonial dispute between the parties, we are of the considered view that there is some scope for settlement between the parties either before the Lok Adalat or before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre.

In view thereof, notice of motion is issued for 19.8.2016 only for the limited purpose of sending the parties before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre for amicably settle their

dispute.”

It has been recorded in the aforesaid order that there is no merit in the appeal, however, still to explore the settlement, the matter was referred to Mediation and Conciliation Centre. Even there, no solution could be found.

Considering the order passed on 11.7.2016, the appeal is dismissed.
