Both the parties were present along with their respective counsel. Ramandeep Kaur has preferred the present appeal aggrieved by the dismissal of the joint petition filed under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act, as petitioner No.2 backed out from the terms and conditions of the compromise during second motion.

Today when both the parties were present, we interacted with them. Petitioner No.2, who is the respondent herein, also agreed to give consent for getting a decree of divorce by mutual consent. We have recorded their statements in second motion. Petitioner No.1 had withdrawn the criminal prosecution launched against petitioner No.2. Petitioner No.2 had paid a sum of ₹ 4,00,000/- towards permanent alimony to petitioner

No.1. It is found that there was no scope for them to live together as

husband and wife. They have been living separately for the past 2 ½ years.

In our view, the averments made in the joint petition filed under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act, are true. Therefore, a decree of divorce by mutual consent is granted and the marriage between the parties is dissolved. Decree sheet be prepared accordingly.

The appeal stands disposed of.
