Appellant is ready with sum of Rs.20000/- towards interim litigation expenses to the respondent besides this he has failed to furnish process fee for summoning the respondent. In view of said circumstances, it appears that the husband is not interested in pursuing the appeal.

When counsel for the appellant was directed to explain the circumstances in which the process fee has not been filed and the interim litigation expenses have not been offered, counsel for the appellant submits that when order dated September 19, 2016 was passed, the appellant was present in the Court but he has adopted an evasive approach to pay the litigation expenses as ordered by this Court.

Counsel for the appellant submits that he has been instructed by the appellant not to furnish the process fee in view of the order of payment of litigation expenses.

In view of the above said circumstances, this Court is of the opinion that the appellant is not entitled to be entertained in his appeal. The appeal is, therefore, dismissed for non-payment of litigation expenses. However, it is ordered that in case the appellant comes forward within a period of six months to pay the litigation expenses, he would be entitled to contest the appeal otherwise, the order would be deemed to have become final.
