The appellant has laid challenge to the judgment and decree passed by Additional District Judge, SAS Nagar, Mohali, vide which a petition under Section 12 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (for short 'the Act') seeking annulment of his marriage with his wife Harvinder Kaur.

2. It was not disputed that during the pendency of the appeal, a settlement agreement dated 18.03.2017 has been arrived at between the parties whereby it has been agreed that the divorce petition under Section 13-B of the Act by way of mutual consent would be filed jointly before the Ld. District Judge, SAS Nagar (Mohali) on 29.03.2017. It was stated that an amount of ₹2 lacs has also been paid to the respondent at the time of first motion.

3. It was prayed by learned counsel for the parties that the present petition may be disposed of as having been rendered infructuous. It was also prayed that in case the respondent does not adhere to the settlement agreement dated 18.03.2017, the appellant be permitted to move an application for revival of the case.
