The appellant-wife had sought dissolution of marriage by filing a petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act but the petition of the appellant-wife had been dismissed by the District Judge, Ferozepur, vide judgment and decree dated 30.09.2016. Aggrieved by the said judgment and decree, the appellant-wife had preferred the present appeal.

During the pendency of the appeal, the matter was referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of the Punjab and Haryana High Court, where the parties arrived at a settlement, copy of which has been brought on record. The said settlement is exhibited as Ex.C-X and made part of the record. As per the terms and conditions of the settlement, the parties have, subject to certain conditions, agreed to stay together.

In view of the said circumstances, the appeal is disposed of as

having been rendered infructuous without prejudice to the rights of the parties to seek revival of the proceedings in case any of the parties feels that the terms of the settlement have been violated warranting recall of this order. Parties will be bound by the terms and conditions of the settlement Ex.C-X.
