This order shall dispose of the above mentioned two LPAs. The facts are taken from LPA No.1768 of 2014 for convenience.

This appeal was preferred against the order dated 13.5.2014 vide which the learned Single Judge vacated the order staying award as the appellant failed to respond to the application under Section 17-B of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947 moved by the

workman.

On 31.10.2014, this Court noticing that the amount under Section 17-B of the Act calculated up to date, i.e., 31.10.2014 was paid to the workman, stayed the execution proceedings till the next date of hearing. The matter has been lingering on since then and we are informed that the writ petition is still pending before the learned Single Judge.

Be that as it may, we are of the opinion that all these issues can be raised before the learned Single Judge and there will be no occasion for us to keep these LPAs alive any further which we dispose of with direction that the appellant shall continue to pay the amount due to the workman under Section 17-B of the Industrial Disputes Act. Needless to say that the appellant would be at liberty to raise all the pleas before the learned Single Judge.

Both the appeals stand disposed of.
