

“ However, out of the compensation amount awarded in favour of the applicants, initially only 15% will be released to them in cash and rest of the amount together with interest accrued thereon, shall be kept in fixed deposit in their

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favour in the same bank for a period of three years in case of a major. However, after one year, 1/3 of the amount will be released to the applicants, another 1/3 after completion of two years and remaining amount will be released after completion of third year.”

The applicants-appellants claim that they need money in one go and that the imposing of the condition is unjust.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances, the abovenoted condition is set aside and the amount of compensation as ordered by the Tribunal is ordered to be released in one go by depositing the same in the accounts of the applicants-appellants, furnished by them.

In view of the above, the present appeal is allowed.
