Notice of motion.

Mr.Karminder Singh, Advocate who is present in Court accepts notice on behalf of the respondent.

Appellants who are parents of the deceased Kulvinder Singh were awarded compensation to the tune of Rs.8 lacs by the Railway Claims Tribunal, Chandigarh Bench, Chandigarh (for short, 'the Tribunal') vide judgment dated 20.4.2017. Appellants are aggrieved by the condition imposed in the impugned judgment, wherein, only 15% of the compensation amount was ordered to be released in cash and remaining amount was ordered to be deposited in fixed deposit and to be paid in installments, as mentioned in the said judgment. The appellants state that they are in the need of the money in one go.

Keeping in view of the circumstances, the condition of remaining amount to be deposited in fixed deposit and releasing the same in

installments is hereby set aside and the entire compensation is ordered to be released in one go to the appellants.

Appeal is accordingly allowed.
