After arguing at length, learned counsel for the appellants prays for permission to withdraw the instant appeal with liberty to approach the learned Single Judge for his grievance regarding the admissibility of monetary consequences as have been granted by one court in similar circumstance in related proceedings while in the impugned order it has been held that in the event of acceptance of the appellants' claim they would be entitled to notional benefits only. Learned counsel states that this is contradictory. The appellants are given liberty to raise their grievance before the learned Single Judge in appropriate proceedings, if so advised.

That apart, we find that the appeal is barred by an inordinate delay of 1280 days which itself would be another reason for us not to interfere.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid granted.
