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MAHESH GROVER, J (ORAL)

This appeal is directed against the judgment dated 20.05.2016 of the learned Single Judge entitling the respondent to the salary for three months when he had worked with the appellants even though under the interim orders of this Court. The respondent was claiming extension in service which was not granted.

Before us, the only argument that has been raised is that at the time of passing of the interim order, the Court permitted the respondent to work but without salary and, therefore, there could not be any variation regarding this interim direction when the final order was passed.

We are afraid such a plea is on the face of it is unacceptable for the interim orders passed by the Courts during the course of hearing can be varied or modified, and when the Court has passed the final order, the earlier order, would loose its significance after the issue has been addressed at

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length and decided in totality. Even otherwise, since the respondent worked with the appellants for three months, he would be entitled to salary for that period.

We do not find any illegality in the order of learned Single Judge and the instant appeal is, therefore, dismissed.
