We do not find any infirmity in the impugned judgment of the learned Single Judge declining the grant of interest. Vide orders dated 6.2.2014 the writ Court had held the appellant entitled to sum of Rs.15,61,392/- to be given by the official respondents within a period of 4 months. There was no stipulation of interest. The amount concededly was released to the appellant on 2.8.2014 i.e after barely 2 months delay which does not seem to be inordinate given the circumstances when the respondents would have been in the process of releasing the amount to the appellant.

Hence, dismissed.
