Prayer in this application filed under Order 22 Rule 4 read with Section 151 CPC is for impleading the legal heirs of deceased-respondent no.2 Bant Singh, who died on 2.6.2014.

Notice of the application.

Mr. Mrigank Sharma, Advocate, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondents no.1 to 3 and does not dispute the death of respondent no.2-Bant Singh. He also does not disputes the legal hairs of respondent no.2 as stated in para 2 of the application.

For the reasons mentioned in the application, which is not opposed, the same is allowed and the persons named in para 2 of the

application, are ordered to be impleaded as legal representatives of respondent no.2. The amended memo. of parties is taken on record.

Prayer in this application filed under Section 151 CPC is for withdrawal of the main appeal in terms of compromise dated 16.12.2016 (Annexure C-1) arrived at between the parties.
