Learned Single Judge decided two writ-petitions by way of a common order dated 23.04.2016. LPA No.1666 of 2016 **(Shri Ram Singh and others versus The State of Punjab and others)** filed in one of two cases has been disposed of by this Court by way of a reasoned order dated 04.11.2016.

The instant letters patent appeal has arisen out of the second case. There is no material change in the facts and circumstances except that unlike the first case, the candidates who were appointed by the Bank through improper or illegal channel, are impleaded as party-respondents. The instant letters patent appeal is also accordingly disposed of in terms of the order dated 04.11.2016 passed in LPA No.1666 of 2016.

Since improperly appointed candidates have been given opportunity of hearing in this case, we see no reason as to why the Bank should not promptly take appropriate action in the matter in the light of the observations made in para No.8 of the above-cited orders.
