This intra-court appeal assails the order dated 26.09.2016 whereby learned Single Judge has dismissed the appellant's writ petition in *limine*. The appellant had challenged the disciplinary proceedings initiated which culminated into issuance of two show-cause notices to him, one proposing major penalty of dismissal from service and the other proposing to recover Rs.12.50 lacs. It further appears that no final orders have been passed pursuant to both the show-cause notices though the same were issued way back in the year 2012.

Learned Single Judge has dismissed the appellant's writ petition, in a way, being pre-mature and rightly so. Needless to say that if any adverse order is passed against the appellant pursuant to the show-cause notices, he shall be at liberty to file departmental appeal and/or thereafter to approach an appropriate forum. The Disciplinary Authority is meanwhile directed to take final decision in furtherance of the show-cause notices,

within a period of three months from the date of receiving a certified copy of this order.

Ordered accordingly.
