This appeal is directed against the judgment of the learned Single Judge dated 17.11.2016 granting compensation of Rs.3 lacs to the deceased workman on account of wrongful termination of his services without following the proper procedure of law and in violation of principles of natural justice.

Before us the solitary argument that has been raised is that the compensation which has been enhanced from Rs.30,000/-, as awarded by the Labour Court, to Rs.3 lacs is highly exorbitant.

After hearing the learned counsel for the appellant, we are of the opinion that it may not be a case of interference in the impugned judgment as this court would not impose its perception qua the quantum of compensation to unsettle what has been

granted by the learned Single Judge by exercising his discretion, unless it is shown to be highly arbitrary. Finding no such manifestation from the impugned judgment, we decline interference.

Appeal dismissed.
