LISA GILL, J.

This revision petition was adjourned sine die on 20.11.2013 as there were repeated written requests for adjournment and none appeared on behalf of the petitioner on other occasions. It is to be noted that notice of motion has not been issued in this case. This revision petition is barred by limitation (47 days).

No effort has been made by the petitioner for listing this case for hearing. This matter was put up for hearing on 25.01.2017 by the Registry. The matter was adjourned for 15.02.2017 and it was directed that the counsel for the petitioner be notified of the date fixed in this case.

Despite the learned counsel for the petitioner being notified of the date fixed, none appeared on behalf of the petitioner on 15.02.2017. In the interest of justice, notice was issued to the petitioner herself for 25.04.2017 to show cause as to why this petition be not dismissed for non-prosecution.

As per office report, notice issued to the petitioner has been received back unserved due to incomplete address. The service report reveals that the petitioner could not be traced at the address given in the memo of parties. A perusal of the file reveals that no address other than the one in the memo of parties is available.

In view of the facts and circumstances of the case, this petition is dismissed for non-prosecution.
