Aggrieved by the dismissal of his petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act by the Family Court, Ambala, the appellant claims to be relieved of certain obligations pursuant to the statement made on the basis of the settlement arrived at prior to the filing of the petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act.

Counsel for the appellant submits that the appellant should be discharged from all the obligations and liabilities accruing from the statement made by the parties in proceedings under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act at first motion pursuant to the compromise. Such an application has been filed by the appellant at the time when the respondent had withdrawn her consent on 06.08.2017 at second motion.

At this stage, counsel for the appellant seeks permission to

withdraw the appeal with liberty to file an application for absolving him of the obligations accruing from the first statement made pursuant to the Compromise Ex. CI, which form part of the record of the lower Court.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to file the said application without prejudice to the right of the appellant.
