For the reasons set out in the application, the delay of 7 days in re-filing the accompanying appeal is condoned.

CM stands disposed of.

**CM-10789-CI-2016**

This is an application for condonation of delay of 486 days in filing the accompanying appeal.

All what has been urged by learned counsel for the applicants is that the matter in issue is squarely covered by the judgment, dated 03.03.2016, rendered by this court in RFA No.2963 of 2015 [**Haryana State Industrial and Infrastructure Development Corporation Limited through its Managing Director and another v. Mangal Singh and others**] and other connected cases, vide which in the appeals arising out of the same acquisition, this court had enhanced the compensation awarded to the landowners.

Ms. Safia Gupta, AAG, Haryana, present in court, on behalf of respondents No.1 & 2, and Mr. Pritam Singh Saini, Advocate, on behalf of respondents No.3 & 4, accept notice.

The factual position, as set out above, is not disputed by learned counsel for the respondents.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the record.

In the wake of the decisions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in Imrat Lal and others v. Land Acquisition Collector and others, 2015(2) RCR (Civil) 437 and Dhiraj Singh (D) Tr. LRs. v. Haryana State and others, 2015 (2) RCR (Civil) 507, delay of 486 days in filing the accompanying appeal is condoned. However, to balance the equities, for the period of delay in filing the appeal the applicants shall not be entitled to any interest on the enhanced compensation.

CM stands disposed of.

RFA-3908-2016

For, the learned counsel for the parties are *ad idem* that the matter in issue is squarely covered by the decision rendered by this court in Mangal Singh's case (supra), the present appeal is disposed of in the same terms. However, the appellants shall not be entitled to interest on the enhanced compensation for the period of delay in filing the appeal i.e. 486 days.
