This is an application seeking condonation of delay of 732 days in re-filing the accompanying appeal.

For the reasons set out in the application, that is duly supported by an affidavit, the same is allowed. Consequently, delay of 732 days in re-filing the appeal is condoned.

Consequently, legal representatives of deceased Shiv Naranyan-appellant No.2, who is stated to have died on 07.08.2013, during the pendency of the Reference, are granted leave to institute and maintain the accompanying appeal.
