This is an application for condonation of delay of 167 days in filing the accompanying appeal.

It is clarified that this order shall have no bearing if any dispute qua the registered will dated 05.06.1993, is pending before any Court.

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Learned counsel for the parties are *ad idem* that the matter in

issue is squarely covered by the judgment, dated 10.12.2015, rendered by this court in RFA No.1235 of 2011 (Chhatter Singh Vs. Haryana State and others), and other connected matters, vide which, in the appeals arising out of the same acquisition, this court had enhanced the compensation awarded to the land owners.

That being so, the present appeal too is disposed of in terms of the decision of this Court in the case of Chatter Singh (supra).
