The appellant is aggrieved of the relief that the learned Single Judge has granted and prays for modification thereof. It has been urged that the charge sheet was dropped in 2013 whereas the date as noticed in the order is 30.12.2015. Apart from that the learned Single Judge has observed that “Therefore, for the delayed payment beyond three months, petitioners are entitled to interest @ 9% per annum on the delayed payment of gratuity and leave encashment.”

Learned counsel for the appellants contends that it is not clear as to from which date these three months would be construed.

After hearing the learned counsel for the appellants, we are of the opinion that these are issues which can be clarified

by the learned Single Judge, if an appropriate application is made. Let the appellants move an application accordingly.
