We do not find any infirmity in the impugned judgment.

The Collector had exercised his discretion and according to the settled law such discretion should not be interfered with unless some perversity is shown. The selected candidate is more qualified, younger in age and has more land and the appellant does not dispute these facts. The plea of the appellant that he acted as Sarabrah Lambardar is inconsequential as the same was found incorrect on the basis of the record. The merits of the rival candidate have been appraised in correct spirit.

No merit.
