The appellant is in appeal against the judgment of the
learned Single Judge dated 23.03.2017. His wife had filed a writ
petition praying that the official respondents be directed to conduct
the regular inquiry into the allegations made by her in a complaint
dated 22.03.2010 against one Mahipal Singh, even though the
preliminary inquiry had indicted him and few others.

The learned Single Judge declined interference on the ground
that it was for the official respondents to see the feasibility of
conducting regular departmental inquiry and we would readily concur
with the same particularly when the wife of the appellant was unable

to show any prejudice that she has suffered on account of the inaction on the part of the official respondents in transactional allegations which were set forth by her in the year 2010. No adverse action was taken against her when she faced the allegations of dereliction in duty in not deposing against the delinquent employee before the Labour Court. We would, therefore, decline interference and leave it to the wisdom of the official respondents to initiate the regular departmental inquiry, if deem necessary.

Appeal dismissed.
