By filing the intra-court appeal, the appellant has approached this court impugning the order dated 8.5.2017 passed by the learned Single Judge dismissing the writ petition.

The appellant had impugned the order of punishment inflicted upon him in pursuance to disciplinary proceedings initiated against him. Initially, he was ordered to be dismissed from service, however, the appellate authority reduced the punishment to stoppage of two annual increments with cumulative effect. The proved case against the appellant, after affording due opportunity of hearing during the course of enquiry, was that he committed fraud in his personal leave account and as a consequence, salary of 180 days drawn by him was ordered to be recovered. Besides this, there were other allegations. The enquiry was conducted by a retired

With aforesaid facts, being on record, in our view, there is no error in the order passed by the learned Single Judge. The appeal is, accordingly, dismissed. Consequently, the accompanying applications are also dismissed.
