The appellants are in appeal against the judgment of the learned Single Judge dated 15.03.2017 awarding a compensation of Rs.6 lacs to the workman for having worked with them for five years and facing illegal termination of his services.

Learned counsel for the appellants contends that the amount awarded is excessive. We, however, do not agree with the contention of the learned counsel for the appellants for the simple reason that the order of the learned Single Judge is based on some rationale that has been adopted which we do not find infirm or erroneous so as to warrant interference in his order under correctional jurisdiction.

However, delay of 84 days in filing the appeal which has been ascribed to procedures is condoned.

Appeal stands dismissed.
