The appellant is in appeal against the judgment of the learned Single Judge who while relying on the earlier precedents of this Court **(Senior Superintendent of Post Offices, Jalandhar Division, Jalandhar vs. Darshan Ram (through L.Rs) and others** reported as 2014(9) SCT 120 (DB) and **Senior Superintendent of Post Offices vs. Smt. Sham Dulari and others** reported as 2006(3) SCT 577) disposed of the writ petition in similar terms. It is not in dispute that those judgments relied upon by the learned Single Judge were carried in SLP before the Hon'ble Supreme Court and met with dismissal. We would thus have no reason to differ with the learned Single Judge when he had disposed of the matter on the basis of earlier precedents and hence, instant appeal deserves to be dismissed. Ordered accordingly.
