Respondent No.6-Kashmir Kaur filed a writ petition praying for issuance of mandamus to permit her to perform the duties as Sarpanch of Village Fatehpur, District Hoshiarpur along with duties of an Anganwadi Worker. The appellant has been agitating against the said respondent by pleading that these two engagements simultaneously are impermissible. She has also preferred an election petition while the respondent No.6 has filed a civil suit.

The learned Single Judge disposed of the writ petition with a direction to the Block Development and Panchayat Officer, Hoshiarpur-I to decide the representation appended to the writ petition as Annexure P-12 after affording effective opportunity to the respondent No.6 as expeditiously as possible

preferably within one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

We are of the opinion that the appellant would have no cause of grievance as the matter has been left open for the Block Development and Panchayat Officer to determine after affording opportunity to both the parties. This would imply that the concerns of the appellant are well taken care of and since he has already been granted an opportunity to present his case before the Block Development and Panchayat Officer, there would be no prejudice to his cause. We also make it clear that whatever material the parties produce before the said officer would be taken into consideration.

Appeal stands dismissed.
