The learned Single Judge has disposed of the writ petition on the basis of an earlier precedent **Smt. Saroj and another v. State of Haryana and others**. Both the counsel for the appellants and that of the respondent were ad idem on this aspect yet this appeal has been filed and no meaningful argument has been advanced. We are thus of the opinion that the appeal is totally frivolous and has resulted in sheer wastage of time of the Court. The same is dismissed with costs of Rs.25,000/- to be deposited in the account of the Punjab and Haryana High Court Employees' Welfare Association, Chandigarh within one month.

Apart from this, the appeal is also barred by an inordinate delay of 211 days which we do not intend to condone in the absence of any plausible explanation.

Dismissed.
