Learned counsel for the appellants contends that they have raised the issue of alternate remedy available with the respondent to approach the Educational Tribunal. However, we notice that no such, preliminary objection has been taken by the appellants in the reply to the writ proceedings. We are unable to comment on the issue whether such a plea was raised before the learned Single Judge or not.

Confronted with this situation, learned counsel for the appellants contends that he would approach the learned Single Judge at the first instance by bringing to his notice the plea that he had raised.

We would, therefore, dispose of the appeal at this stage with liberty to the appellants to approach the learned Single Judge.
