The present appeal is directed against the judgment of the learned Single Judge dated 30.11.2017 declining the request of the appellant for providing adequate security to him due to threat perception from some gangster in the year 1997.

There is no infirmity in the impugned order of the learned Single Judge in declining the writ petition. It is always for the State law enforcing Agencies to consider the threat perception to any individual and provide security, if required.

We, therefore, leave it entirely to the State Agencies to take a decision on the representation (Annexure P15) of the appellant in accordance with law.

Appeal stands disposed of.
