This appeal is directed against the judgment of the learned
Single Judge dated 19.01.2016.

As a writ petitioner the appellant sought quashing of order dated 29.12.2012 passed by the Registrar, Co-operative Societies, Haryana rejecting his representation to be absorbed in the Gurgaon Central Co-operative Bank Ltd. in which he alleges the parent society where the appellant was employed got merged in the year 1994. There is nothing on record which would suggest the merger or its terms. The appellant seeks to rely on a resolution passed by his erstwhile society suggesting the absorption of the appellant in the resultant society i.e. Gurgaon Central Co-operative Bank Ltd. but it would be difficult to accept the fact of merger therefrom. Rather the order of the Registrar, Co-operative Societies is unambiguous and states that the Ujina Farmers Service Co-operative Society (parent society of the

appellant) was not amalgamated in the Gurgaon Central Co-operative Bank where the appellant sought absorption as a Clerk. We thus do not find any infirmity in the impugned order, particularly when the appeal is also barred by an inordinate and unexplained delay of 302 days.

Dismissed.
