Appellant has a limited grievance. Learned counsel for the appellant has submitted that as per the judgment passed by learned Additional District Judge, proceedings before the Deputy Registrar, Co-operative Society against the award passed by Assistant Registrar is pending. He submits that the Deputy Registrar should be allowed to decide the controversy independently without being prejudice by the findings of the Court.

I have considered the submission. In this case, learned First Appellate Court has held that possession is with the Co-operative House Building Society. Needless to say that Deputy Registrar while deciding the case on merits would be entitled to decide the same in accordance with law.

Appeal is disposed of.
