This appeal has been filed after an inordinate delay of 633 days which has been explained in para 3 of the application. We are not inclined to accept the explanation given in the application. Even if the best case of the appellants is accepted, there was a huge delay in filing the writ proceedings as well. Once having approached the court and getting dismissal in limine, as the impugned order would suggest, it can hardly be expected that the appellants would not be in the know of the proceedings. A litigant is also supposed to be vigilant about his case and such a casual explanation shifting blame on the counsel that he had not informed them about the fate of their case cannot be accepted, particularly when the litigants are educated persons

and would be expected to have a reasonable follow up of their own grievance.

No ground to interfere.

Dismissed on the ground of delay.
