This intra-court appeal assails the interim order dated 03.04.2017 whereby learned Single Judge has declined to grant ad-interim stay to the appellants against the order of cancellation of their promotion.

We find that the order of cancellation has been passed by the State Government under the fear of contempt of Court proceedings emanating out of some interim orders passed by the learned Single Judge in some other case. We are of the view that to get any effective relief, the appellants would be well advised to seek modification of the interim orders passed from time to time in CWP No.13160 of 2016 (Gulzar Singh and another versus State of Haryana and others). If need be, the appellants can also seek their impleadment as party-respondents in that case. No effective relief against those interim orders can be granted in independent proceedings initiated by the appellants.

With these observations and liberty, the appeal stands disposed of.
