It is not disputed that there were two criminal cases pending against the appellant as a result of which the passport authorities declined the travel documents to him. In both the criminal cases cancellation report has been submitted and in one case it has been accepted while other is still pending before the Court of competent jurisdiction.

Before us learned counsel for the appellant makes a limited prayer for acceptance of the cancellation report in case FIR No.159 dated 12.8.2016 registered under Sections 307, 332, 186, 436, 341, 283, 506, 323, 148, 149, IPC, Section 3 of the Prevention of Damages of Public Property Act and Sections 25, 27, 54 of Arms Act at Police Station Lalru pending in the Court of Judicial Magistrate, Ist Class, Derabassi.

We are unable to accept the prayer which is presently in the domain of the Court where such a process is pending and thus without

commenting on the merits of the case simply dispose of the instant appeal by

exercising our supervisory jurisdiction under Article 227 of the Constitution of India to direct the District Judge, Mohali under whose jurisdiction the aforesaid Court falls to look into the matter and ensure disposal of the matter in accordance with law at the earliest. We make it clear that this is neither a mandate to accept or to reject the cancellation report and it shall be done solely in accordance with law by the Court concerned.

Disposed of in above terms.
