The present appeal has been filed under Clause X of the Letters Patent for setting aside the order passed by learned Single Judge in **Civil Writ Petition No.1432 of 2016** on 04.10.2016, order dated 09.09.2013 (**Annexure P-8**) passed by the State Transport Appellate Tribunal, Punjab and order dated 17.12.2003 (**Annexure P-1**) passed by the State Transport Commissioner, Punjab.

2. Learned counsel for the appellant did not dispute that the order impugned herein dated 04.10.2016 was passed in a bunch of thirteen writ petitions including Civil Writ Petition No.9036 of 2015 as well. It was further not disputed that in Letters Patent Appeal No.7 of 2017 which was filed challenging the decision rendered in Civil Writ

Petition No.9036 of 2015, the same was withdrawn on 10.01.2017 in the following terms:-

'After arguing at length, learned counsel for the appellant prays for permission to withdraw the instant appeal with liberty to approach the official respondents with a plea that the permit which is lying un-used be set up for grant afresh.

Permitted to do so.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid granted.'

3. Learned counsel for the appellant prayed that the present appeal may also be disposed of in the same terms.

4. Ordered accordingly.
