The appellant is in appeal against the order of the learned Single Judge dated 27.03.2017 declining his prayer for fixing the Civil Writ Petition on an actual date.

The appellant, who is appearing in person, contends that the order is non-speaking. He has made the request for an actual date before the learned Single Judge on the ground that he is a senior citizen and his writ petition merits an early disposal.

The language of the impugned order suggests that since the application has been made soon after the admission of the writ petition on 27.12.2016 prayer was declined.

The Letters Patent jurisdiction is a correctional jurisdiction. There is no error of law or jurisdiction committed by the learned Single Judge so as to warrant any interference by us. Therefore, we would dispose of the appeal with an observation that the appellant

being a senior citizen may bring this fact to the notice of the learned Single Judge through an application at appropriate stage, if so advised.

Appeal stands disposed of.
