(1) This Letters Patent Appeal challenges the order dated 30.01.2017 whereby appellant's writ petition questioning the order of termination of her services has been dismissed.

(2) The appellant was engaged on contract basis as a Computer Operator through outsourcing agency, namely, Oscar Security and Fire Services. She was appointed in the Punjab Health System Corporation at CHC, Ahmedgarh, Sangrur on 28.06.2016. Her services were dispensed with on 19.08.2016 on the ground that the said Outsourcing agency was not authorized to make appointment on contract basis as such an assignment has been given to some other agency. The appellant challenged the said order before learned Single Judge and her writ petition has been dismissed.

(3) We have heard learned counsel for the appellant. The appointment through outsourcing agency for a period of one month or so did not confer the appellant with a right to continue in the service or to seek reinstatement as she was never engaged by the respondent-Corporation. The subsequent alleged replacement of the appellant by another employee engaged through the outsourcing agency does not mean that the appellant has got an indefeasible right to continue on contract basis.
