HARI PAL VERMA J.(Oral)

Learned counsel for the parties state that the dispute between the parties has been resolved through mediation proceedings. The settlement/compromise dated 2.6.2016 has been placed on record. Relevant extract of the settlement dated 2.6.2016 read as under :-

“(i) Both the parties have agreed that the first party will make an application to the Electricity Department for shifting of his electric connection along with transformer etc. from Killa No.23/2 of Muraba No.81 to KJilla No.18 of Muraba No.81 and he himself will shift his polly house Kotha etc. in Killa No.18 of Muraba No.81 and the second party will not be liable to make any consideration to the first party for the same. As told by both the

parties vegetable crop is in Killa No.23/2 and it will ripe up to 20th November, 2016.

- (ii) It has been further agreed that they will exchange their killas mentioned above which have come in their share in partition proceedings by the Assistant Collector up to 20th November, 2016.
- (iii) If either of the party will back out from the settlement/compromise then the other party is at liberty to pursue the RSA No.4853 of 2013 titled as “Munni & others vs. Krishna Devi & others” in this Hon'ble Court.
- (iv) It has also been agreed between the parties that as per this settlement the first party will withdraw the RSA No.4853 of 2013 titled as “Munni & others vs. Krishna Devi & others” on the date fixed.”

Learned counsel for the parties jointly state that the present appeal may be disposed of in terms of settlement/compromise dated 2.6.2016.

In view of the joint statement of learned counsel for the parties, the present appeal is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous, in terms of settlement/compromise dated 2.6.2016.
