Plaintiffs are in second appeal against the concurrent judgments and decrees passed by the Courts below.

Plaintiffs filed a suit for declaration of their ownership over the suit property on the basis of adverse possession.

In view of settled legal position, plea of adverse possession can only be set up as a defence. The suit filed on such a plea is not maintainable.

Accordingly, the present regular second appeal is dismissed.
