This is an application for condonation of delay of 1793 days in filing the appeal.

All what has been urged by learned counsel for the applicants is that the matter in issue is squarely covered by the judgement dated 23.04.2016, rendered by this Court in **RFA No.2176 of 2012**, titled “Rajinder versus State of Haryana”, vide which, in the appeals arising out of the same acquisition, this Court had enhanced the compensation awarded to the landowners.

Notice.

On the asking of the Court, Ms.Safia Gupta, AAG Haryana, present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent.

The factual position as set out above, is not disputed by the learned State counsel.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the record.

In the wake of the decision of the Hon’ble Supreme Court in *Imrat Lal and others v. Land Acquisition Collector and others, 2015(2) RCR (Civil) 437* and *Dhiraj Singh (D) Tr. LRs. v. Haryana State and others, 2015 (2) RCR (Civil) 507*, delay of 1793 days in filing the accompanying appeal is condoned. However, to balance the equities, for the period of delay, the applicants shall not be entitled to interest on the enhanced compensation.

CM stands disposed of.

CM No.2867-CI of 2017

For the reasons set out in the application, that is duly supported by an affidavit, same is allowed, subject to all just exceptions. Consequently, legal representatives of deceased Bhim Singh S/o Pohlu-appellant No.2 and Smt. Shanti D/o Pohlu-Appellant No.6, who are stated to have died, as depicted in para No.2 and 3 of the application, are brought on record, for the purpose of pursuing the appeal only.

CM stands disposed of.

**CM No.2865-CI of 2017 and
RFA No.1147 of 2017**

For, the learned counsel for the parties are ad idem that the matter in issue is squarely covered by the decision rendered by this court in *Rajinder's case (Supra)*, the present appeal is disposed of in terms of the said decision. However, the appellants shall not be entitled to interest on the enhanced compensation for the period of delay in filing the appeal i.e.1793 days.
