Learned counsel for the appellant fairly points out at the outset that the matter in issue is squarely covered by the judgment dated 03.09.2015, rendered by this court in RFA No.2718 of 2011 [**Dilbagh Singh and others v. State of Haryana**] and other connected cases, vide which the appeals arising out of the same acquisition preferred by the claimant/land owners as also the State were dismissed and the compensation awarded by the Reference Court was affirmed. And, that being so, the present appeal shall have to be dismissed.
