This is an application seeking condonation of delay of 3 days in filing the accompanying appeal.

All what has been urged by learned counsel for the applicant is that the matter in issue is squarely covered by the judgment, dated 11.03.2016, rendered by this court in RFA No.1475 of 2012 [**Ajit Singh v. State of Haryana and others**] and other connected matters, vide which in the appeals arising out of the same acquisition, this court had enhanced the compensation awarded to the landowners.
